INFORMATION for APPLICANTS

Becoming a member - The applicant immediately becomes a member, when rule 7 has been fulfilled,
An applicant for membership of the Association becomes a member when —

- (a) the committee accepts the application; and
- (b) the applicant pays any membership fees payable to the Association under rule 12.

and is then entitled to exercise all the rights and privileges of membership, including the right to vote (if applicable), and must comply with all of the obligations of membership under these rules. The committee must notify the applicant of the committee's decision to accept or reject the application as soon as practicable after making the decision.

Member to receive rules – section 36(1) (b) of the Act provides that the association must give each person who become a member of the association of copy of the rules in force at the time their membership commences.

Format of rules provided - It is acceptable for the association to provide a copy of the rules to new members by electronic transmission or providing the details for the website whether the rules may be downloaded. A hard copy must be provided if the member requests that the rules be provided in that manner.

Voting rights of Members

- Each ordinary member of the Association has one vote at a general meeting of the Association.
- Each ordinary member of the Association that is a body corporate has one vote at a general meeting of the Association.
